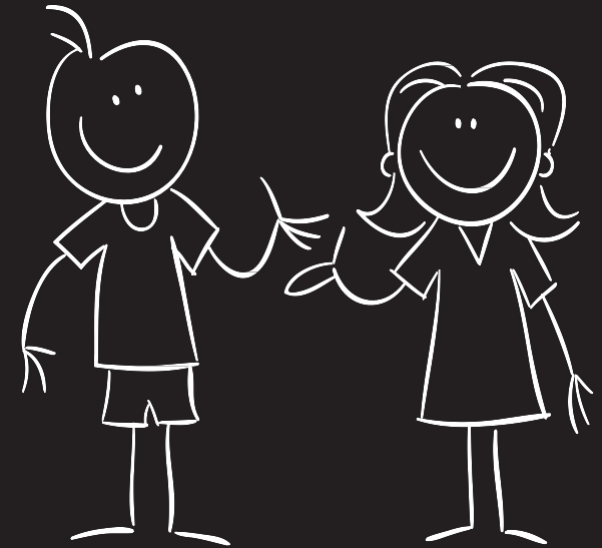
# CT 4-H Mentoring Project
