The **CLUB COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD** application form must be completed and received in the 4-H office by May 1. Project must be completed from May 1 - April 30.

Activities that will not count toward this award include: activities that benefit 4-H- like helping at the Fair. etc. Please call the 4-H office if you are not sure if your activity is appropriate.

Who can apply? Any enrolled 4-H group completing the requirements.

Type of award - rosette ribbon will be given to recipients during our annual Recognition Night.
